- 1. Entry fee shall be \$4.00 per entry and pen rent of \$8.00 per pen, if exhibitors do not enter in Open Class. BEFORE UNLOADING check in with superintendents with your health papers and they will assign and restrict pens, including tack pens, on a space available basis. If requested pens are not available, pen rent will be refunded.
- 2. NO LIVESTOCK MAY BE UNLOADED BEFORE 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 13. All hogs must be in place by 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, July 13 and will be released at 4:00 p.m. Sunday, July 18.
- 3. Exhibitors are responsible for barn cleanup. To facilitate barn, clean out, hogs must be out of the barn by 6:00 p.m.
- 4. All swine exhibited must meet state health requirements. All swine will no longer require blood testing for pseudorabies and brucellousis in the state of Illinois.
- 5. All pigs shall be farrowed on or after January 1st and before April 1st and be property of the exhibitor.
- 6. Exhibitors may show more than one breed but only two entries per entry number may be made. No more than 2 monies will be paid in any class (a weight division being a class).
- 7. All animals exhibited in the purebred classes (gilts or barrows) must be registered in the exhibitor's name or family name on or before June 1st. Registration papers must be presented at time of weighing and remain on fairgrounds. This rule will be strictly enforced.
- 8. All barrows must have been fed by the exhibitor and have been the property of the exhibitor on or before June 1. Record books must be kept from June 1 to fair date.
- 9. Barrows shall be castrated by June 1. Any barrow showing evidence at fair of testicular tissue shall be disqualified and sent home. Barrow weight groups will be established on Wednesday after weighing.
- 10. ALL PUREBRED AND CROSSBRED PIGS must be ear notched but not fresh notched.
- 11. All Gilts and Barrows will be weighed only on Tuesday. No re-weighs.
- 12. All purebred gilts must be weighed and will be shown according to age.
- 13. Any exhibitor washing an animal in an inappropriate spot other than a wash rack will forfeit all their premiums. NO feeding in the wash rack. Hogs brought to the fair MUST be clean upon arrival.
- 14. Barrows may not weigh over 290 lbs. to show for Champion. The champion and reserve champion will be selected for each gilt and barrow breed. The champion in each breed will compete for Grand Champion. The reserve champion for the breed chosen as Grand Champion will show for Reserve Grand Champion.
- 15. We will pay 55 sub classes based upon the number of entries in each breed.
