- 2. All purebred Dairy animals must be registered in the exhibitor's name. Papers will be checked. All Meat Goats will be considered Commercial for the Open Meat Goat Show. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE IDENTIFID BY A SCRAPIE TAG OR APPROPRIATE TATOO.
- 3. Entry fee shall be \$6.00 per entry. Mail entries to Entries, PO Box 301, Crescent City, IL 60928.
- 4. Pen fee shall be \$10.00 per pen with a maximum of 3 animals per pen, unless pen fee is paid in Junior Show.
- 5. Exhibitor may make two entries in each class.
- 6. No bucks allowed. Wethers shall be castrated or banded prior to May 1.
- 7. No horned dairy animals.
- 8. NO LIVESTOCK MAY BE UNLOADED UNTIL 8:00 a.m., Tuesday. July 13 and not later than 3:00 pm. All animals will remain for the duration of the fair and will be released after 4:00 pm, Sunday, July 18.
- 9. Health regulations of the State of Illinois must be followed and health papers will be collected.
- 10. Dairy animals entered in Dam & Daughter, Get of Sire, and Produce of Dam classes MUST ALSO be shown in their appropriate age classes in order to be shown as part of a pair or group.
- 11. Entries must be made on entry blanks in fair book. All entries must be mailed to Entries, Box 301, Crescent City, IL 60928. Entries close on June 28.
- 12. Dairy Goats will be judged on Saturday, July 17 at 8:00 am. The Meat Goat Show will be one hour after the Dairy Show.
- 13. Any animals which possess any percentage of meat bloodline must be shown in the meat classes ONLY.
- 14. All meat and dairy wethers must be born on or after October 1st., 2020. There should be NO VISIBLE SIGN OF A SCROTUM and all castrations must be healed or the animal will not be allowed to show. NO HORNS ALLOWED ON WETHERS.
- 15. Wood chips will be the only bedding allowed. NO STRAW.
- 16. Items used and stored in goat barn will be at the discretion of the goat superintendents.
- 17. ALL LIVESTOCK TRAILERS MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE FAIRGROUNDS AFTER UNLOADING TO FREE UP PARKING.
- 18. DO NOT ENTER CHAMPION CLASSES.
